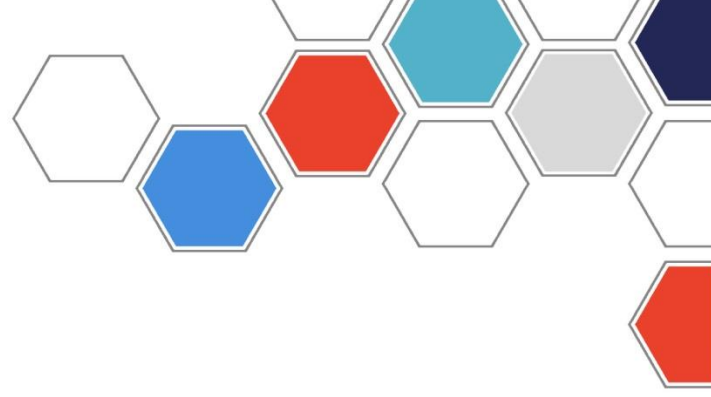

Questions to ask your physician

Here are a few questions you should ask your physician, prior to having stem cell or blood platelet treatment:

1. To date, how many procedures has your medical facility completed?
2. Do you use a patient's own stem cells and blood platelets?
3. Do you keep a patient database? If so, based on the patients you treated, what is the success rate of your treatments and how is this determined?
4. Is your infection rate 0%?
5. Do you use a bedside "one-size-fits-all" approach or are you able to create personalized treatments for patients?
6. Do you use advanced imaging guidance, such as fluoroscopy and/or MSK ultrasound to ensure precise placement of cells into the injured area?
7. Are your physicians board certified?
8. What area(s) do your physician(s) specialize in?
9. How many years have your physicians been practicing regenerative medicine and interventional orthopedics?
10. Do your physicians have any published research?
